## Kempegowda's 108

### foot statue built and inaugurated in Bangalore

Kempegowda was a chieftain under the Vijayanagar empire in early modern India. Kempegowda was the most revered in his line of Yelahanka rulers and was well admired and appreciated by his people.

He was solely responsible for the transformation of Bengaluru from a sleepy village to a center of Vedic traditions to a metropolitan city. He encouraged the construction of buildings, lakes and residential layouts.

In his honor, a 108-foot statue was built in Bengaluru recently. This majestic statue in Devanahalli is 218 tonnes and its construction was overseen by three generations of the Sutar family and was inaugurated by honourable Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, on November 11th.

## Rishi Sunak becomes UK's first British Asian Prime Minister



On 25th October 2022, former Chancellor of the Exchequer, Rishi Sunak was inaugurated as the United Kingdom's fifty-seventh Prime Minister by King Charles III after Sunak's predecessor, Liz Truss's early resignation.

Sunak's grandparents migrated from India to Southeast Africa. His parents were born in South Africa. They later moved to the UK where Rishi Sunak was born on 12th May, 1980. His early political career started off with him being elected as a Member of Parliament and soon serving as a Chief Secretary to the treasury. He quit his job as the Chancellor of Exchequer in 2022 and announced that he would stand for election on 23rd October, three days after Truss leaving the office.

After his opposition withdrew from the elections, he was nominated for office and quickly took over. World Citizens hope that Rishi Sunak can bring stability and prosperity to Britain and guide the nation through all of the current hardships.

## Russia Declines Peace Talks

The Russia Ukraine War has been going on for about ten months and there has been no shortage of casualties. More than 100,000 soldiers have been killed on either side, with countless civilian deaths and injuries as well.

Russia is going on to the next stage of its military campaign and is threatening Ukraine with nuclear warfare. Though it would be in everyone's interests to end the war, Vladimir Putin is refusing to give up, and is rejecting any requests for peace talks.

Foreign powers such as America and NATO are not making any efforts to actively stop the bloodshed, as they claim that there is nothing they can do until Putin decides to end the war. Putin is accusing the west of indirectly attacking Russia by supporting Ukraine and giving military and logistical support to Ukrainian troops. He feels that the measures he is taking are necessary and that the demoralizing attacks happening on the Ukrainian infrastructure and people were inevitable.

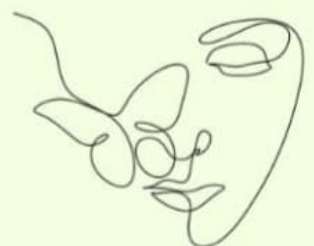
## Gaia BH1, the closest black hole, to be found



Black holes occur in space when a star ages and dies. It produces a gravitational pull around it so strong, that matter taken in by a black hole cannot escape. However, they pose no threat to us unless we try to enter one.

This is why scientists were thrilled when they discovered a black hole almost 1,560 light years away from earth. The black hole, dubbed Gaia BH1, was found by astronomers in Hawaii with the use of the Gemini North Telescope. Gaia BH1 is the closest black hole that has ever been detected near Earth. After careful observation, scientists have confirmed that this black hole is ten times bigger than our sun.

# ISRO To Explore Venus

ISRO is planning a mission, 'Shukrayaan' to Venus in December 2024, the aim of the mission being to study the planet's atmosphere, which is toxic and corrosive as it is covered by clouds of sulphuric acid.

Venus was the first planet to be explored by a spacecraft when NASA's Mariner 2 successfully launched on December 14, 1962. Since then, numerous spacecrafts from the US and other space agencies have explored Venus, including NASA's Magellan, which mapped the planet's surface with radar.

The satellite is planned to be launched onboard the GSLV MK II Rocket. The Institute of Space Physics (ISP)'s Satellite instrumental Venusian Neutrals Analyzer (VNA) will study how the charged particles from the Sun interact with the atmosphere and exosphere of the planet.

## Kohli becomes first player in history to cross 4000 runs in T20 cricket!

Star Indian batsman Virat Kohli became the first player in history to cross the 4000 run mark in T20 International cricket on 10th November. India's star batter accomplished this amazing feat during his sides's second semi-final match against England at the Adelaide Oval.

In the match, Kohli scored a delightful 50 off 40 balls . His knock consisted of four boundaries and one six. His strike rate during the match was 125.00. This was his fourth half-century of the ongoing edition of the tournament. He is currently the leading run scorer with a score of 98.66 . This also includes his instant classic knock of 82 off 53 against Pakistan at Melbourne.

With this half century, his sum-total is of 4008 runs in 115 Matches across 107 Innings at an average of 52.73 . One century and 37 half centuries have come out of his bat so fast with the best individual score of 122\* . His strike rate in the shorter format is 137.96 .

## Musk Buys Twitter!

In January 2022, business magnate Elon Musk began buying shares of the American social media company Twitter, eventually becoming the company's biggest shareholder in April.

Twitter soon invited Musk to join its board of directors, an approach which he initially approved before rejecting soon after. Later on, Twitter welcomed Musk's buyout proposal for 44 billion dollars on the 25th of April . In July, the company suddenly filed a lawsuit against Musk when he claimed that Twitter breached their mutual agreement by denying to crack down on spam bot accounts. The trial was then terminated on October 27, with Elon Musk becoming Twitter's new holder and CEO.

Upon gaining ownership of Twitter, Elon Musk promptly fired many head executives , including the preceding CEO, Parag Agrawal. Many staff abdicated their jobs after Musk issued a requirement commanding them to commit to their work to an extreme degree. Several Twitter employees have voiced concerns about Musk's intentions..
