SRI LANKAN TOURISM IN FOR A MAKE OVER?

The Sri Lankan government is set to launch the 'Visit Sri Lanka' app, targeting five million tourists. President Ranil Wickremesinghe announced that the app will be released in the upcoming months and claims that the app is in the final stages of development. The Government targets to bring in almost 5 million tourists highlighting that the industry is an important economy booster. It has also recognized the diverse culinary style of the country and shall henceforth make more developments in the culinary sector. This move is being expected to make a rebound in the economy of Sri Lanka that recently collapsed due to a number of reasons. Plans to develop Lanka's tourism sector is anticipated to plant new hopes on reviving the financial stability that crashed last year.

In 2016-2017, a drought ruined crops and weakened the farming industry. Politics also was a factor, with a sudden, unexpected change in government in 2018, and terrorist attacks by Islamic fundamentalists in 2019. Major tax reform contributed to a weakened budget. Hence, the improvement in the tourism and hospitality industry is being looked forward to promise a gradual recovery of the economy of Sri Lanka.

THREAT ON HUMANITY

The root cause of the Israel-Palestine war can be traced back to the ownership of land that is today recognised as Israel. Although controversial, the land was initially occupied by Palestinians for over a millennium but this land was united as a country under the flag of Israel in 1948. The regions of West Bank and Gaza strip were inhabited by the former Palestinians, who were now Israeli citizens.

A few Islamic activists of Palestine, who did not accept this change formed an organization called Hamas. Hamas aimed to create an Islamic state in the region of present-day Israel. They have made the Gaza strip and West Bank as their frontiers, planning and executing their attacks from these places.

This war is threatening the lives of tens of thousands of people, not only of the armed forces but also of innocent civilians. The United Nations Security Council is trying hard to communicate with both Israel and Hamas and convince them to stop the war. At the least, the Council is requesting the parties to give 'humanitarian pauses' through the Gaza strip to provide civilians with desperately needed aid.

"War may sometimes be a necessary evil. But no matter how necessary, it is always an evil, never a good," said Jimmy Carter. War is not the ultimate solution for any problem. Let the world look for a peaceful way of dealing with our differences rather than picking up arms to destroy humanity.







